Make your vision board of your financial future and your dream life. A vision board is a tool used to help clarify, concentrate, and maintain focus on specific life goals. Literally, a vision board is any sort of board on which you display a collection of images that represent whatever you want to be, do, or have in your life. Choose only words and images that inspire you and make you feel good. Keep it neat, and be selective about what you place on your vision board because you'll be looking at it every day. You can put images of both "short-term" and "long-term" goals.


- Collect images according to your financial goals.
- Make the images of the top 5 goals you selected bigger than the other images.
- Have "short-term" and "long-term" goals on your vision board.
- Make sure you are excited about the images you are looking at.
- Add inspirational words on your vision board.
- Have pictures of money goals/work and business goals/personal growth goals/ health goals/fun and recreation goals/spiritual goals.
- Before you visualize every day, always make sure your emotional vibration is within the frequency of hope and bliss. If not, take action to feel good first.
- Look at your vision board every day. It is best to do this first thing in the morning and at night before bed time. Visualize everything on your board as a reality and be grateful for it. Make sure you have a positive feeling of gratitude when you visualize.
- Visualize everything happening before your eyes and use all of your senses: appeal to the sense of sight, the sense of touch, the sense of taste, the sense of hearing, the sense of smell, because the five senses all have their inner counterparts.

## STEP 3: CREATE YOUR MONTHLY BALANCE SHEET

It's very important to keep track of your spending and expenses; that way, you will get more clarity as to where you are spending your money and what expenses you can cut off next month to save more.

The 'Spending Summary or Expense Tracker' will help you to keep track of all your spending and expenses throughout each month.
A Write down all the amounts of your monthly expenses in your Monthly Balance Sheet (Housing, Transportation, Loans, Food, Personal, Medical and Health, Other).
B Think of a target amount for each category, and then write it down in the column called 'Budgeted'.
C Write down the actual amount that you are paying for each category in the column called 'Actual.'
D Calculate the total amounts for 'Budgeted' and 'Actual', fill those amounts in, then calculate their difference and fill in that amount in the column that says 'Difference'.


## STEP 4: PLAN THE MONTH AND FINANCIAL TASKS

Before you fill in your monthly action plan, always reflect back on your one-year financial goal first.
A) Fill in your financial goal for this month, visualize yourself achieving your goal, and feel grateful for it.
B Set a reward for yourself if you achieve your goal.
C) Write down all your income sources' names and the amounts you are making from them, then write down the total amount of those income sources.
D Write down all your savings' names and their amounts, then write down the total amount of those savings amounts.
(E) Use this section to list your most important appointments, meetings, reminders, and events this month.
(F) Use this section freely to write down ideas, notes, or mind maps.


## STEP 5: KEEP TRACK OF YOUR SAVINGS GOALS

By keeping track of your savings goals each month, you will keep getting inspired and motivated by reminding yourself of your bright financial future.
A Write down the name of the item/subject you are saving for.
B Write down the monthly goal you are aiming for.
C) Write down the reward you will give yourself if you achieve your savings goal.
(D) Write down the monthly deposit amount you need to make to achieve your savings goal.
E Keep following up each month by making this deposit. Write down the date of when the deposit was made, its amount, the method that was used to make the deposit (Debit Card, Credit Card, Wire Transfer, Check, Cash, Bitcoin), and the remaining balance of the overall savings goal.


## STEP 6: KEEP TRACK OF PAYING OFF DEBT

One of the most critical aspects of you becoming financially free is to pay off your debts as soon as possible, especially the ones with high interest rates.
A Write down the name of each debt and its starting/remaining balance.
B Write down the minimum payment you need to make each month for it, and the due date of that payment.
C Keep following up each month by making the needed payment with the vision of paying even more than the minimum payment. Then write down the date of when the payment was made, its amount, the method that was used to make the payment (Debit Card, Credit Card, Wire Transfer, Check, Cash, Bitcoin), and the remaining balance of the debt.
